

DANCE FLOOR SIZE CHART

The best way to calculate how many square feet you will need is take the total number of guests, divide by 2 (because only 1/3 to 1/2 of the people will dance at one time), and multiply by 4.5 square feet per person. This gives you the approximate square footage you will need for dancing, and then use this chart to pick the dimensions closest to that number.
